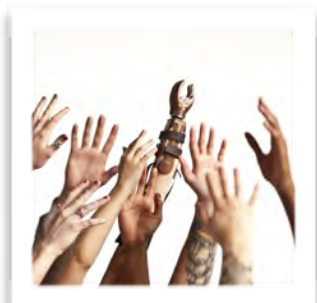

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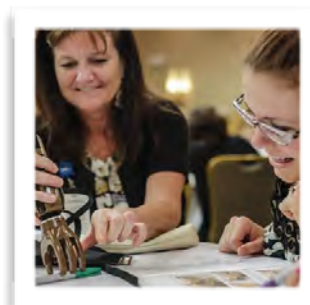
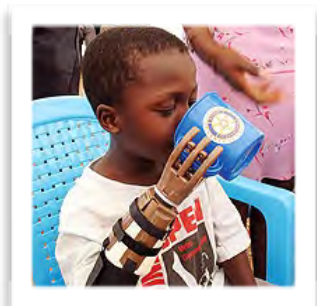


Helping Land-Mine Victims in the Developing World

The **Helping Hands Project** is a truly unique opportunity for organisations to get involved with a worthwhile cause at the same time as super-charging employee engagement. More than just team building, participants in our programs build prosthetic hands that are then donated to amputee land-mine victims throughout the developing world. The activity empowers every participant in just a few hours to make a real and lasting contribution, and in doing so reminds people what it feels like to be engaged in a truly purposeful activity.



Suitable for groups from 5 to 500 and working in teams of 3, participants are provided with a bag of parts and instructions and will assemble their prosthetic hand. Each team member's dominant hand is also covered to further remind them why they are doing the activity.



Our facilitators can include eventpod's Australian **Special Forces** bomb disposal experts who have witnessed at first hand the devastation IEDs and land-mines cause to civilian populations in Afghanistan, Iraq, Africa, Cambodia and other developing countries.

The programme takes 2 to 3 hours to complete and is the perfect accompaniment for any conference or meeting. It brings teams together in a worthwhile cause and will provide an experience they will remember for many years. Participants are left feeling energised, inspired and filled with a sense of purpose.
